- *Mexican Mint Marigold* (*Tagetes lucida*), also known as Mexican tarragon, is an *herb* and distinct from **French marigold flowers** (*Tagetes patula*) in the **Durango Outback Mix**.
- *Avoid disturbing the roots of cucumber, squashes, and melons when transplanting.
- Projected harvest is based on ideal conditions (i.e. consistent watering). This calendar is based on the school year. If you plan on having a summer garden, your planting window is longer.
