

HOW TO PLANT & CARE FOR YOUR SNOW PEAS



- Start your peas indoors.
- Fill your container with potting soil. Plant your peas one at a time 1" deep.
- Put your seedling in a sunny area and water gently 1-2 times a day.
- You should see sprouts in 5-10 days.



- With proper care, seedlings will be ready to transplant at 2-3 weeks. Transplants should have 3-4 mature leaves.
- Gradually introduce your seedlings to direct sunlight for a few hours daily, 1 week before planting outdoors.
- Dig a hole matching the size of the seedlings' roots, place them in, cover with soil, and gently press them in. Plant seedlings 2" apart in rows 6" apart.



- Trellis your seedlings with posts and twine, to support plants as they grow.
- Water in the mornings to keep plants hydrated and the soil moist.
- Peas take 60-80 days until harvest.
